Brothers and Sisters of Local Union 488,

Today, Friday, September 18, 2020, one employee who works for Fluor tested positive for Covid-19.

Fluor has 88 UA workers on dayshift that were sent home today. IPPL and Fluor have conducted contact tracing as per their Covid-19 policy, which exceeds the AHS minimum guidelines. They are deep cleaning and disinfecting all offices, lunchroom and site areas affected.

All orientations for Fluor that were scheduled between Sep. 21 and Sep. 25 have been canceled.

All workers with a slip in hand will be contacted with a new orientation date.

All other workers on dayshift are to be back on site on Monday, Sep. 21, 2020.

**If Alberta health services contact you through tracing, follow all instructions given.**

The measures being taken by Fluor and IPPL to keep you all safe after this positive case are incredible. **You can rest assure upon returning to work on Monday morning, you will be safe.**

As a Business Manager, I want to remind all of our members: Follow the guidelines that the government has put in place to protect all of us. Follow the sanitary protocols that are set on the job sites for the same reason. If you feel unwell or have the suspicion that you are not well, please volunteer yourself and get tested. If you think you may have been in contact with anyone who is sick or shows symptoms of Covid-19, please proceed and get tested. This is a difficult situation for all of us. It affects us all in all aspects of our lives.

I would also like to remind everyone to keep calm and every day before leaving your homes go through your minds the list of the Covid related symptoms:

COVID-19 Symptoms	
• new or worsening cough	• muscle aches
• shortness of breath or difficulty breathing	• body aches
• temperature equal to or over 38°C	• new loss of smell or taste
• feeling feverish	• headache
• chills	• gastrointestinal symptoms (abdominal pain, diarrhea, vomiting)
• fatigue or weakness	• feeling very unwell
