Shifts will be: Days - 4/10's and an 8-hr shift and Night Shift - 5/9's

All workers dispatched will require the full work ready workforce safety certifications as well as:

- 1) WHMIS 2015 Certificate
- 2) CSTS 2020 - 7 modules as listed below (CSTS 3.2 or CSTS 09 will not be accepted)
 - CSTS-2020 Fundamentals
 - Basic Scaffold Safety
 - Controlling Hazardous Energy & LOTO
 - Environmental Protection
 - Mobile Equipment Awareness
 - Propane on the Work Site
 - Working at Heights

The welding requirements for site will be carbon and stainless GTAW, with CWB for all welders being dispatched.
