Dear Members:

Our office has been notified that certain individuals within the Alberta Construction and Maintenance industry are calling for an illegal walk out/work stoppage next week on some of the maintenance sites covered by our collective agreements.

This communication is written to remind those members working under the GPMA and NMA Agreements in Alberta that Article 28.100 contains a no strike no lockout provision as outlined below.

ARTICLE 28.000 WORK STOPPAGES

28.100 During the term of this Agreement there shall be no lock-out by the Company and no slowdown or work stoppage by any of the Unions.

It is expected that our members will continue to work should any disruption occur as we need to fulfill our contractual obligations under the Collective Agreement.

Please contact your local union Business Manager to ensure that they remind their members of our obligations.
